  - Click “Print.”
  
3. Lyrics
  - File → Print.
  - Under “Pages, choose “Range.” Enter the numbers “5” to “34.”
  - Click the box that says **“Two-Sided.”**
  - Click “Print.”

#### **Using Acrobat:**

1. Cover (print in color if possible)
  - File → Print.

2. Table of Contents (**OPTIONAL**)
  - File → Print.
  - Click “Pages,” and enter “3.”
  - Click “Print.”
  
3. Lyrics:
  - File → Print.
  - Click “Pages,” and enter “5 - 34.”
  - Click box that says “Print on both sides of paper.” Make sure “Flip on long edge” is selected.
  - Click “Print.”

When placed in a notebook, **odd-numbered pages (1, 3, 5, etc.) should appear on the right-hand side;**  
even-numbered pages (2, 4, 6, etc.) should appear on the left-hand side.
